



ANNEX A – RELEVANT PROVISIONS UNDER THE BROADCASTING ACT (BA)

- a. Section 16(1) of the BA, where “*The Authority may issue directions in writing to a broadcasting licensee requiring the licensee to take any action with regard to the contents of programmes or advertisements or to broadcast standards that the Authority considers necessary in order to comply with the provisions of this Act, any relevant Code of Practice and any condition attached to the broadcasting licence.*”;
- b. Section 13(2)(b) of the BA provides that an IASP must comply with the Conditions of the Broadcasting (Class Licence) Notification;
- c. Condition 13 of the Broadcasting (Class Licence) Notification provides that a licensee (IASP) shall use its best efforts to ensure that its service is not used for any purpose, and does not contain any programme, that is against public interest;
