

GET SUBSIDISED BROADBAND AND LAPTOP/TABLET

DigitalAccess@Home

A scheme that provides subsidised broadband and laptops/tablets to lower-income households to support their lifestyle needs, including work and social activities.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Low-income households living in HDB flats with at least one Singapore Citizen are eligible to apply for DigitalAccess@Home.



Existing beneficiaries of subsidised broadband or subsidised devices (under either the Home Access or NEU PC Plus schemes) will not be offered DigitalAccess@Home's subsidised broadband or subsidised devices respectively.

IOW MUCH DO I NEED TO PAY? (CO-PAYMENT)

The amount of your co-payment will depend on the product(s) you select. The table below shows the range of co-payment amounts:

Applicant Type	Broadband ³ (per month)	Tablet ⁴	Laptop ⁴
Tier 1 / Public Rental Scheme ¹	\$5	\$75 - \$85	\$220 - \$235
Tier 2 / Reside in 1-3 Room ²	\$10	\$155 - \$165	\$445 - \$475
Tier 3 / Reside in 4 room or Larger	\$15	\$230 - \$250	\$665 - \$710

¹Households with any beneficiary of either MSF ComCare Assistance or MOE Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS)⁶, and with GHI ≤ \$1,900 or PCI ≤ \$650, qualify for this tier of support.

² Households with any beneficiary of MOE FAS⁵ and \$1,900 < GHI ≤ \$3,400 or \$650 < PCI ≤ \$900 qualify for this tier of support. ³For 500 Mbps. To subscribe for 1 Gbps service, each household pays an additional \$5 per month.

⁴Digital devices offered under Digital Access@Home come with Microsoft Office (only for laptops), 3-year subscri<mark>ption to anti-virus software services, and 3-year warranty.</mark> ⁵This includes MOE FAS for mainstream schools and Special Education Financial Assistance Scheme (SPED-FAS) for special need schools.
