Case Summary	StarHub alleged that SingTel had breached Section 3.3.3 "Duty to Provide Service on a Non-discriminatory Basis" and Section 7.2 "Abuse of Dominant Position in the Singapore Market" of the Telecom Competition Code ('Code") in relation to SingTel's anti-competitive behaviour with respect to the prices quoted or offered by SingTel to its end-users and other competing licensees for IDD services, Local Leased Circuit services and ISDN services.
IDA's Determination	IDA had assessed that StarHub's evidence was insufficient for IDA to proceed with its enforcement request against SingTel. However, to ensure that StarHub's concerns would be addressed, IDA sought SingTel's clarification on the issues raised. Based on SingTel's clarification, IDA found that there was no evidence to suggest that SingTel had acted inappropriately or anti-competitively as alleged. IDA therefore decided not to proceed with enforcement proceedings on SingTel for breach of Sections 3.3.3 and 7.2 of the Code.
